Statement in Response to the Incident at Manchester Airport**

The National Association of Muslim Police (NAMP) are aware of the distressing videos circulating on social media in relation to the recent incident at Manchester Airport.

A police officer has now been suspended from all duties and a referral has been made to the Independent Office for Police Conduct for a full independent investigation.

All members of the police service are expected to be professional and proportionate when handling such incidents. We hope that this matter will be dealt with appropriately.

The National Association of Muslim Police and local Muslim networks are working with the Greater Manchester and other police forces across the UK to address concerns raised by the community, partner organisations and members within the wider police service.

We are deeply concerned about this incident. It has not only had an impact nationally but also internationally as well.

We understand circumstances like this may result in further incidents of hate crime. We want to remind anyone experiencing any form of hate incidents to report this to your local police force. Alternatively, you can also report it via <https://www.report-it.org.uk>, 101 or 999 in an emergency.

The National Association of Muslim Police advocates for and promotes an inclusive workplace across the police service.

We will continue to support the communities and colleagues who have been affected by the recent events and hope this matter will be addressed accordingly.
